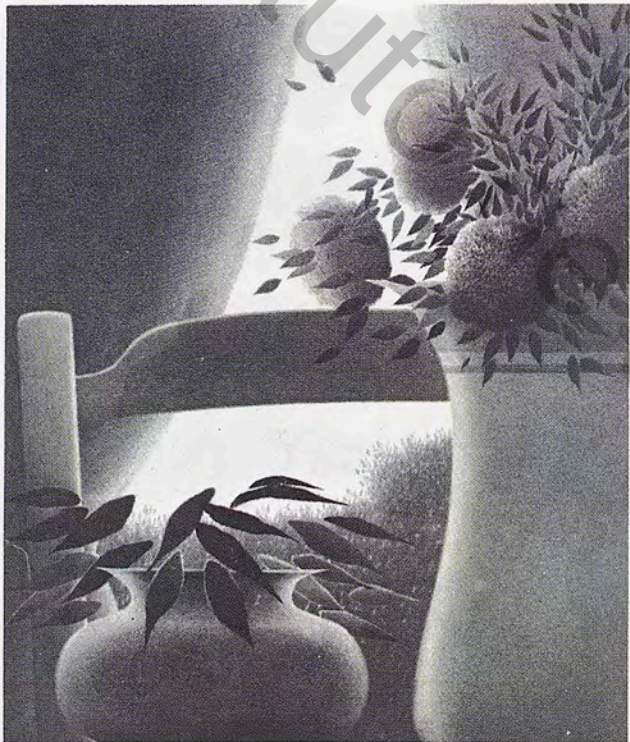

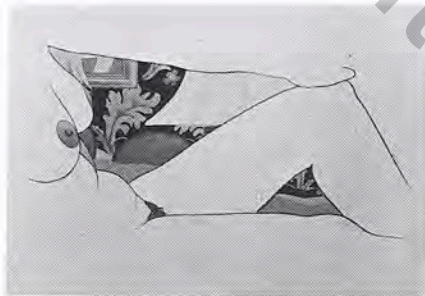

Tom Wesselmann at Sidney Janis & Sander

Tom Wesselmann is showing two years of new work at two New York galleries in November: Sidney Janis, 110 West 57th, and Sander, 51 Greene Street in Soho. Wesselmann's classic "American Nudes" have taken a new turn in these drop-out silhouette canvases in which the figure is implied largely in the space outside the canvas. The female presence is provocative in its absence; the wall enters dynamically into the whole in these unusually shaped free-form images combining painting, drawing and relief sculpture.

The exhibition opens at Sidney Janis Thursday, November 3rd and at Sander on Saturday, November 5th. Both shows continue through Saturday, November 26th.

National Highlights

NEW YORK

Michael Mazur at Barbara Mathes Gallery

An exhibition of Michael Mazur's recent work from the *Wakeby Day/Wakeby Night* series opens at Barbara Mathes Gallery, 851 Madison Avenue, on November 5 and continues through November 30. The exhibition includes monotypes, pastel over monotypes, drawings and paintings. Wakeby Lake on Cape Cod and its surrounding vegetation are the subjects of this series.

Michael Mazur has explored the unique properties of monotype for over ten years and has produced prints much larger than those usually done in the medium. The process involves painting on glass or metal and then transferring the image onto a sheet of paper by pressure. The monotype combines the spontaneity of painting with the inevitability of the reversed image of prints.

Jean Dubuffet at Donald Morris Gallery

The Donald Morris Gallery will begin its twenty-fifth season with a major retrospective exhibition, "Jean Dubuffet: Two Decades, 1943-1962" on November 1. Dubuffet, one of the most important and influential artists of the twentieth century, produced his greatest works during this period, many of which are included in this comprehensive survey.

The exhibition is held under the High Patronage of His Excellency Bernard Vernier-Palliez, the Ambassador of France to the United States and formally opens with a benefit for the Lycee International, Southfield, Michigan on October 31.

A fully illustrated color catalogue accompanies the exhibition. It includes an introduction by Mr. Vernier-Palliez and an essay by the noted art historian Dore Ashton.

NEW YORK

Stephen Greene at Marilyn Pearl Gallery

An exhibition of recent paintings by Stephen Greene opens at the Marilyn Pearl Gallery, 38 East 57th Street, on

November 15th. Greene, who has had three museum retrospective exhibitions and has shown in Canada, Mexico, Italy and all over the United States, will be having his twentieth New York show.

Brian O'Dougherty wrote in *The New York Times* in 1964 of Greene, "(He) is a perfectionist with a marvelous obsessive flaw that keeps him continually on the move, a connoisseur of sensations continually wounding the exquisite." More recently the critic April Kingsley wrote, "His recent canvases are more deeply resonant in color and more assertively brushed than any I've seen before."

These latest works continue the artist's concerns for color, surface and the personal symbols for which he is known.

LOS ANGELES

"Painted Objects" at Herbert Palmer

"Painted Object Painted," an exhibition illustrating the changing concept of still life in the 20th century, is on view at the Herbert Palmer Gallery through November 5. Contrasting more than 30 historical and contemporary works of this century, the exhibition suggests that the approach of today's artists to painted objects has become more painterly, bolder in the use of color, more spontaneous and arresting, less studied and less tied to specific movements. Masterworks by Braque and Morandi, Morgan Russell and Eugene Berman are among the earlier works that provide a basis for comparison with both painting and sculpture by contemporary notables such as Arman, Nevelson, Thiebaud, Bourgeois, Ruscha, and emerging talents David Banks, Ronna Harris, Gary Komarin, and Elen Feinberg. The current attitude toward materials and techniques in approaching painted objects is further demonstrated in works in wood by Italo Scanga, Charles Arnoldi and John Okulick; in ceramic by Richard Shaw; in twigs and lithograph by Japanese artist Schoichi Ida.

In replacing the old definition of still life with the term "painted object," this exhibition points up the contemporary artist's return to the object not only as a trend in itself but also as a means for discovering numerous new directions.

Katherine Porter at Arts Club of Chicago

A small survey of major works by Katherine Porter, organized by the Arts Club of Chicago, opens November 16 and continues through December 31. The exhibition will include ten paintings selected from 1976 to the present, with works from the Guggenheim Museum and Philadelphia Museum Collections. The survey begins with paintings marking Porter's departure from the order of the grid to more powerful, yet controlled abstract forms that contain specific symbolic and emotional meaning. It concludes with two mural sized paintings: *The City* and *The City at Night* painted in New York City in 1982 and 1983 respectively.

Katherine Porter was born in Iowa 1941 and studied at Colorado College and Boston University. She currently lives in Maine. Porter was included in the 74th American Exhibition at the Art Institute of Chicago and most recently is represented in the permanent collection of the Museum of Modern Art in New York.

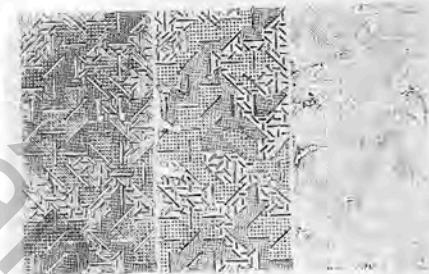
Jay McCafferty at Grapestake Gallery

Jay McCafferty will be premiering his new series of "Solar Burn" paintings at Grapestake Gallery, October 20 through November 26, 1983.

In the new paintings, all based on the triptych format, McCafferty has limited the color in his paintings to that which is generated by the burning process, in sharp contrast to the flamboyant use of paint in his earlier works. In what may be interpreted as a return to the basic elements, McCafferty is allowing the burnt holes and tracings of fire and smoke to stand as the sole record of his gestures. The paper and canvas sections in the triptych echo the patterning of round and linear burns in their counterparts, yet retain their own distinctive character. This is primarily due to the manner in which the materials respond to the burning process and the

conditions (wind, moisture, intensity of sun) under which they are burned.

NEW YORK

Ursula Wolff Schneider at Ingber Gallery

Ursula Wolff Schneider was born in Berlin in 1906, the daughter of Dr. Fritz Wolff, a renowned Sanskrit scholar who encouraged independence in his children. So it was not surprising that Miss Wolff set out to make her mark in the male-dominated field of photojournalism, having grown up in the country that invented the form.

Her pioneer work included photographing the modern Bauhaus architecture, works of art, and thematic studies of people in their daily lives and struggles. Her powerful, evocative photographs brought her quick recognition, and her photo-stories appeared in journals in Germany and abroad. In 1937, she was one of the many artists and intellectuals forced to flee Germany and find refuge in America.

Photographs by Ursula Wolff Schneider are in the collection of the Boston Museum of Fine Arts, the Metropolitan Museum, Columbia and Harvard Universities, the British Museum, and many other museums and institutions in Germany and Italy. She

has had one-person exhibits in her native Germany, and in Chicago and New York. The present exhibit demonstrates her range and facility as she documented the daily patterns of life in Germany between the two great wars.

Nadezda Nada Vitorovic at Nathan Silberberg Gallery



Nadezda Nada Vitorovic, a leading artist of Yugoslavia's new wave, is known in her country for her surrealist paintings. Her dynamic meshing of mythical images makes innovative use of people and birds, both real and spectral. This, her third U.S. exhibition, features drawings which are surrealist depictions of the past.

Edwin Dickinson at Hirschl & Adler Modern

A retrospective exhibition of the work of Edwin Dickinson (1891-1978) will be held at Hirschl & Adler Modern, 851 Madison Avenue, from November 3 through November 30. Sixty works will be on view, dating from 1912 to 1964.

Dickinson was highly respected both as an artist and as a teacher throughout his career. His influence, however, extends beyond his students and remains relevant today because of his innovative approach to painting — to "cloth" and "grease" as he was apt to refer to his canvas and paints. A simple glen, a stone tower or a beach might have served Dickinson as subject matter, yet his considerations were always abstract: the objects or scenes depicted were but armatures for abstract considerations of shape, line and color.

Jane Freilicher at Kansas City Art Institute

An exhibition of paintings by Jane Freilicher will open on November 19 at the Charlotte Crosby Kemper Gallery of the

Jose de Rivera is one of the few sculptors who has consistently fashioned his work by hand, using industrial metals. He recalls Brancusi's pride in the mastery of materials, the emphasis on craft, the laborious efforts taken. De Rivera speaks of entering into a dialogue with materials:

You must establish an equilibrium between the steel and space. You forge it, then hammer it, drown it in water, and then hammer it some more. It is the master; you are the slave. Some days you look at it and don't do anything, some days you just hit it with a hammer. When you stop hammering it is done. There are no more changes to be made. Then you are the master and have attained a feeling of creative achievement.

Rodrigo Moynihan has long been admired for two qualities which many often feel are a mutual contradiction — the virtuosity of his handling of paint and the serious scholarliness which informs his work. Still lifes and self-portraits make up his latest exhibition at the Robert Miller Gallery, 724 Fifth Avenue, New York, (October 25-November 19). The still lifes — shelves bearing clusters of studio objects — are by now established as a major phase in Moynihan's work and are distinguished in recent still life painting. The quiet tonal changes, rhythmic alterations between brisk and leisurely handling, the supportive geometry of shelf, wall or bracket which acts as a vice on objects already in close formation — these are the constants of paintings which allow Moynihan a freedom and variation greater than at first seemed possible.

Jacobo Borges at CDS Gallery

Working through his obsession with the city, Borges came to value above else the retrieval of memory. From his studies of the relatively abstract situation of the fiances, Borges conceived a Balzac-like ambition to make a grand account of specific individuals and their destiny. He chose the hallowed ritual of communion which he took in the broadest sense. Borges began an ongoing series of imaginary portraits of female communicants rendered in every possible situation — those who wait, those who dream, those who fiercely participate, those who are mature, those who are masked as children and those who are children masked as adults. In this enormous psychological investigation, Borges encountered in himself many hidden propensities. All of art history seemed to flood into his work, as did all the insights he had hoarded during so many years of restless experiment.

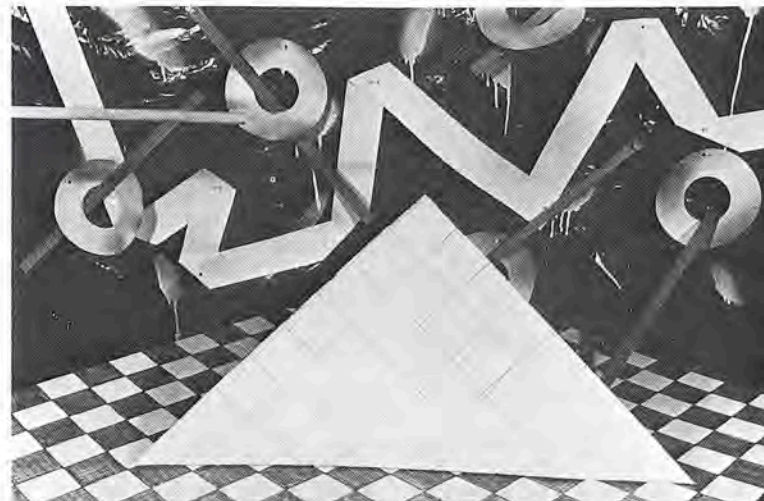

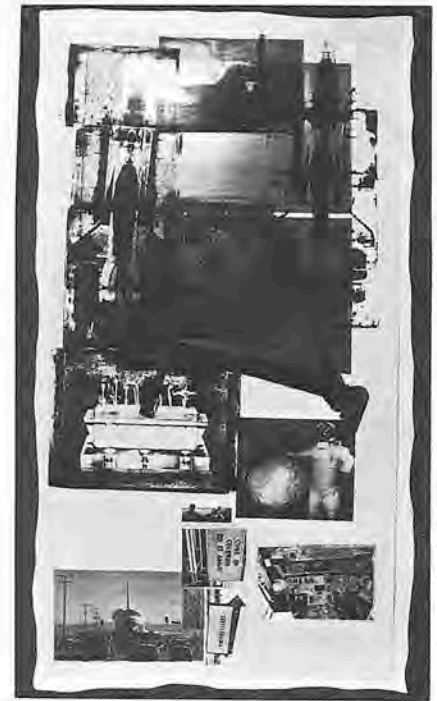
