

Montreux, 16th May. 1973.

Dear Mr. Camargo,

As told you in my last letter, the Countervalue of N. Crs. 30000.- in Swiss francs has been placed at your disposal at your bank in Geneva. The Crs. amounted to S. frs. 16,230.-, and the transfer bank is Union de Banques Suisses, Montreux, the date being 14th May 1973.

The Countervalue of N. Crs. 20000.-, i.e. S. frs 10,820.- is placed at a blocked account bearing your name at Union de Banques Suisses at Montreux. They will be transferred by my order when the sculpture has safely arrived at Trondheim.

When receiving your invoice amounting to N. Crs. 10000.-, the Countervalue of this amount will be transferred to your bank in Geneva.

Please send me now a receipt
of N. Crs. 30000.-. Receipts for
the rest, you'll send me when the
transfers have been executed. All
together you will then have sent
me receipts for N. Crs 60000.-.

Please note that the receipts
shall be in N. Crs. not in Sw. frs.
