I understand that when I was away you asked us to send you a cheque for \$2,000 to your account.


I may be able to do this at the end of the month but at the moment I am expecting certain payments to be made and until these are forthcoming I cannot send you any money.

Frankly I do not feel too badly about it as I did tell you some months back that you were free to sell your work, both from your studio and from the shows you have been having in Germany. You have not been tied down to an exclusive arrangement.

It is not perhaps a bad moment to say in a very friendly way that you are always extremely uncompromising in your price structure and the money I have to pay you for your work. This attitude is rather unrealistic.

The entire commercial world is going through a crisis and the art world, which is an unnecessary luxury, is suffering the most.
