director of the Institute Nacional de Artes Plásticas (INA?) which, as
you probably know, constitutes the visual arts arm of FUNARTE, the Federal

In his letter to you he is asking for the possibility of MOMA offering the chance for a 3 months trainee program on exhibitions design and installation for the head of his International Exhibitions department, Iole de Freitas, in 1986.

I know Tole for many years and want to recommend her as a very serious, capable and hard working person. She is an industrial designer that worked for several years in Italy, including at Olivetti, speaks very good english and worked in the Nucleo de Desenho Industrial at the Federação das Industrias on the installation of the famous design exhibition received from MOMA. I chored the Museum of Modern Art (Nyc) for the wellknor quality of the design department projects. In 1979, I already had an opportunity to work with MOMA design department; it was by the occasion of the MOMA DESIGN EXHIBITION, installed at the Nucleo de Desenho Industrial (S.Paulo) where I was the coordinator of the design department.

By the other Kand, the choice of the MOMA is due to the fact that they are specialized in Contemporary Art, and at the National Foundation for the Arts (Funarte), where I am workains for the time exing, we also concentrate all our activities around in contemporary Brazilian Art. Besides the opportunity of developing my personal professional knowledge, this trainse period will give me new informations and experiences that well be usefull in Funarte as coordenated of the design department and as assistant-director of the National Institute for Fine Arts. We give the cnical and conceptual assistance to all Brazilian States, in cities located all over the country.
