TERMS OF INDEMNITY

If, while the objects are in the care of the South Bank Board Limited or in transit to and from any of its premises or the venue of the exhibition, any of them is (except as the result of war) lost or destroyed or suffers damage which cannot fully be made good, with the owner's consent, by the South Bank Board Limited, the South Bank Board Limited will make compensation to the owner as follows:

- a) in the case of loss or destruction of one or more of the objects, payment of an amount or amounts equal to the agreed value shown above
- b) in the case of such damage to one or more of the objects as aforesaid, payment of
  - 1) such reasonable costs of repair to the objects as may be agreed between the owner and the South Bank Board Limited, or, in default of agreement, may be determined by an arbitrator mutually acceptable to the owner and the South Bank Board Limited
  - and 2) an amount equal to any reduction in the market value of the objects after repair, such amount to be agreed between the owner and the South Bank Board Limited, or, in default of agreement, to be determined by an arbitrator mutually acceptable to the owner and the South Bank Board Limited
