TERMS OF INDEMNITY

If, while the object is in the care of the South Bank Board Limited or in transit to and from any of its premises or the venue of the exhibition, it is (except as the result of war) lost or destroyed or suffers damage which cannot fully be made good, with the owner's consent, by the South Bank Board Limited, the South Bank Board Limited will make compensation to the owner as follows:

- a) in the case of loss or destruction of the object payment of the sum of
Fifteen thousand American dollars US \$ 15,000
- b) in the case of such damage to the object as aforesaid, payment of
- 1) such reasonable costs of repair to the object as may be agreed between the owner and the South Bank Board Limited, or, in default of agreement, may be determined by an arbitrator mutually acceptable to the owner and the South Bank Board Limited
 - and 2) an amount equal to any reduction in the market value of the object after repair, such amount to be agreed between the owner and the South Bank Board Limited, or, in default of agreement, to be determined by an arbitrator mutually acceptable to the owner and the South Bank Board Limited
