


Agreement

Mr. Sergio de Camargo has undertaken to produce a sculpture for the County Hall of Sør-Trøndelag. Said sculpture being made of white Carara marble as shown in photos, shall be placed on a black marble socle in the entrance hall and reach from the floor to the ceiling of the ground floor.


The conditions for doing this shall be:

- 1) The black marble socle shall be one piece and the white marble sculpture another. They shall be constructed so as to enable the sculpture to pivot, when some force is used, on the socle.
- 2) Mr. Camargo shall ship the two pieces f.o.b. from nearest harbour with destination Trondheim.
- 3) When shipped the goods shall be protected against damage in the best possible way.
- 4) If damaged, Mr. Camargo undertakes to make a new sculpture for the same price and under same conditions as the first one.
- 5) The price of the sculpture exclusive socle shall be N. Kr. 60.000,- of which one half the amount shall be paid when this agreement is signed by Mr. Camargo, the second half when the goods is delivered at Trondheim.
Payment shall be made to his account: Sergio de Camargo, No. 141.931.4 at Swiss Bank Corporation, 2, rue de la Confédération, Genève.
- 6) Black marble socle, freight and insurance of the goods shall be paid by The County Hall in addition to the price of the sculpture.
- 7) This agreement has been issued in two copies, one for Mr. Camargo and one for The County Hall.
