I would like to take this opportunity to thank you again for participating in the World Open-air Sculpture Exhibition and for entering such a marvelous sculpture.

On August 21, 1989, we sent you a letter regarding an explanatory plaque to be placed in front of your sculpture. As we explained in that letter, the Seoul Olympic Sports Promotion Foundation plans to install the plaques in metal to describe the artist's motivation behind the sculpture and the technique involved.

Therefore, we would like to ask you once again to send us a short explanation of your sculpture in English (half or one full page in A4 format) by the end of October at the latest. If we do not receive an interpretation from the artist, the sculpture, we feel, would not be understood by a large number of spectators - a tragedy indeed.
